

Rebuking vs. Judging

Rebuking is the correction of a matter. To make sure someone knows better. We usually do this because we care for someone.

Luke 6:31

I personally want my loved ones to tell me when I'm being stupid.

We are to rebuke those we care about as a parent rebukes their child or as Yahuah rebukes us when we slip up.

Leviticus 19:17
